- 2<sup>nd</sup> thing to do is complete “TIPS” training at this web address <http://www.tipsalcohol.com>

This TIPS training will make you eligible to volunteer at:

1. TCF Stadium (Vikings and Gophers Football, Concerts and others)
2. U of M Mariucci, Williams, Ridder, Pavilion arenas
3. Target Center (Timberwolves, Lynx and Concerts)

- To volunteer at Target Field(Twins and concerts) you will need to complete the attached training navigation which is for DNC/Target Field training
- Also attached is the training link to get trained to volunteer at the Xcel Energy Center(Wild Hockey and Concerts)
- Once you have completed these training sessions and have received a TIPS ID Number you may start to sign up and volunteer at the events that you have the training for.

- A guide to go by is - students can ONLY volunteer at the U of M and DLS events.
