NWEA MAP Testing begins April 10-May 11 Grades 1-8

What is MAP?

MAP is a computer adaptive test created by NWEA that kids take two times each school year. The results provide teachers with information to help them deliver appropriate content for each student and determine each student's academic growth over time.

What does it mean to be computer adaptive?

Computer adaptive test adjust to each student's learning level, providing a unique set of test questions based on their responses to previous questions. As the student responds to questions, the test responds to the student, adjusting up or down in difficulty.

What does MAP measure?

MAP is use to measure a student's performance level at different times of the school year and compute their academic growth.

What tests will my child be taking?

Reading---Grades 1-8

Math---Grades 1-8

Language Arts----Grades 3-8

Science----Grade 5-8

***Teachers will communicate with you when testing takes place for your child's grade.

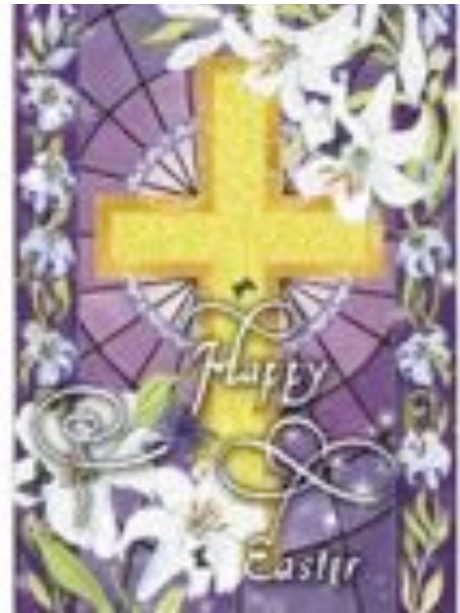

Protecting God's Children lessons begin in April

Teachers will email you the list of lessons that will be taught at your child's grade level.

The personal safety lessons teach children and youth basic skills that help keep them safe from dangerous or abusive situations either in person or online.

The personal safety program consists of four 30 to 40 minute lessons per year per grade for Catholic school children. The lessons approved by the archdiocese are age-appropriate and respect parents' role as their children's primary educators.

The teachers will be using an online program called NetsSmartz.
