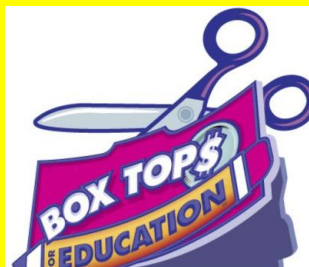
Tuition Contracts for 2017-2018 Now Due!
