Protecting God's Children lessons begin in April

Catholic schools and parish faith formation, sacramental preparation and youth ministry programs throughout the archdiocese began teaching children and youth about personal safety and sexual abuse prevention in 2006.

The personal safety lessons teach children and youth basic skills that help keep them safe from dangerous or abusive situations either in person or online. Young people are taught to check with a trusted adult first, say no when confronted with an uncomfortable situation and are encouraged to share concerns with a trusted adult.

The personal safety program consists of four 30 to 40 minute lessons per year per grade for Catholic school children. The lessons approved by the archdiocese are age-appropriate and respect parents' role as their children's primary educators.

The teachers will be using an online program called NetsSmartz.

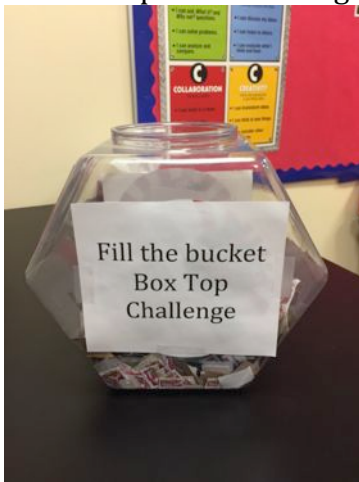
