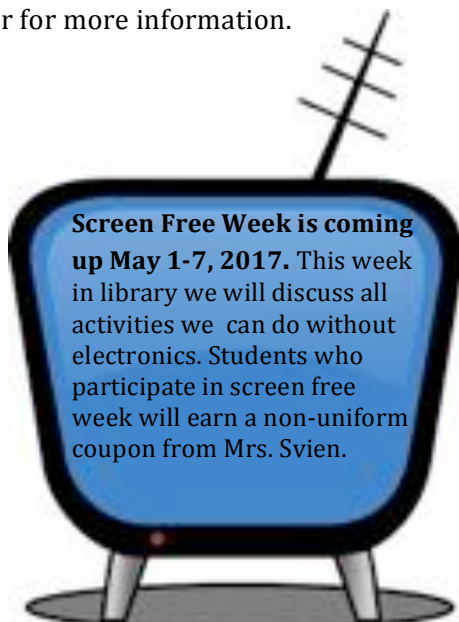
We celebrated Administrative Assistant Day on Wednesday

4th graders attended STARBASE

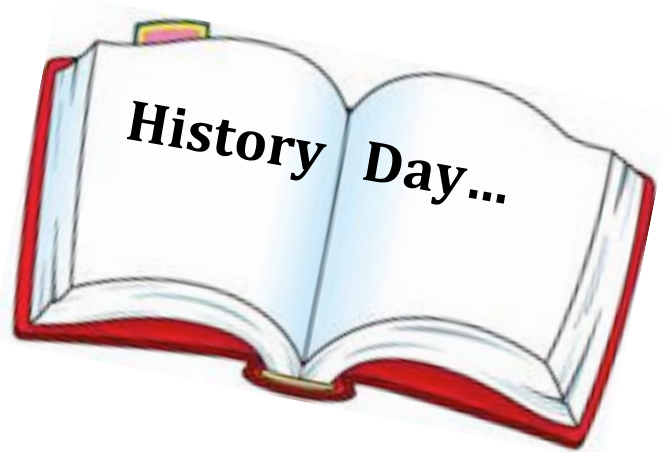
